

# 2016 Industry Academic Fellowship Program

The **Industry Academic Fellowship (IAF)** program provides students with the opportunity to conduct team-based interdisciplinary research. During the course of this eight-week summer program,\* participants will conduct research with a team of undergraduate and graduate students, and educators and industry professionals, while exploring the business-related aspects of technology.

### **Nanotechnology / Interdisciplinary •**

Use of state-of-the-art research facilities at Yale/SCSU (NSF funded CRISP MRSEC). Research teams will work collaboratively with industry professionals on projects involving nano-medicine and nano-environmental studies. We will also explore the business aspects of technology.

**Eligibility •** This program is open to highly motivated undergraduate science students in all disciplines who have completed their sophomore year. Minorities, women and persons with disabilities are strongly encouraged to apply.

**Application Process •** The selection of IAF candidates is based on a personal statement, resume, academic transcript, and one letter of recommendation. The application will be available starting November 1, 2015 at: <http://southernct.edu/nanotechnology>

**\*Stipend •** Each participant will receive a stipend of up to \$5,000; \$3,000 during the eight weeks in the summer, and \$2,000 during the preceding spring and following fall semesters.
