SCSU is now recruiting highly motivated undergraduate science students for our summer research program. Gain practical and professional skills needed for advanced research, graduate programs, and STEM careers.

Participants will conduct team-based interdisciplinary research. Research teams will work collaboratively with industry professionals on projects involving nano-medicine and nano-environmental studies.

Students will participate in weekly business related workshops, led by faculty from the SCSU School of Business. Students will learn about topics such as intellectual property, marketing, and patents. Students will gain knowledge of the technical aspects of industry related research as well as the business aspects.
